Please help couples who are struggling in their relationship to renew their love for each other and grant them new hope for the future. Amen.

#### MON & CHRISTMAS DAY

- Rejoice today that Jesus Christ left the perfect bliss of heaven to come to earth, born of Mary in a lowly stable, to change the whole world and become our Saviour! May we worship Him with joy and gladness because of all He has done!
- Remember older and infirm people who live by themselves and perhaps feel forgotten and isolated, especially the 500,000 who are alone over Christmas. Pray for more Christian volunteers to support local initiatives that visit those in their own homes and residents in care homes. (carehomefriends.org.uk)
- Lord, we lift to You those who are parenting alone because their partner has died or is absent for other reasons. Fill them anew with Your love and give them hope for the future, even if they are feeling daunted by challenges in the year ahead. Amen.
- Pray that the Government will acknowledge the evidence that shows men and women in a marriage relationship are more likely to stay together and successfully raise a family. Pray it will keep its commitment to support married couples in the taxation system, especially those with children, who struggle to make ends meet.
