

Coffee cup collection September and October

Our coffee cup collection is for the work of the Prison Fellowship who show Christ's love to prisoners by getting alongside them and supporting them and their families in various ways. For example they run the 'Angel Tree' project which brings joy to many children who have a parent in prison. Volunteers enable prisoners to improve family relationships by sending a purchased, wrapped gift to their children at Christmas. It also runs 'Sycamore Tree' courses in prisons that encourage offenders to take responsibility for their crimes and to recognise the impact it has had on their victims and their community. One of our church members is a volunteer helper on a Sycamore Tree course that is currently running in one of our local prisons. Revd. Sue Smith who lives in Stone is a chaplain in a local prison and she will be speaking to us in our **Morning Worship Service on 21st October**. We will also be serving 'real' coffee that has been roasted by the young offenders in Aylesbury prison.

Stone War Memorial needs your help
