Mark 8:31-38

³¹ He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. ³² He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him.

³³ But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter. "Get behind me, Satan!" he said. "You do not have in mind the concerns of God, but merely human concerns."

³⁴ Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me. ³⁵ For whoever wants to save their life^[a] will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me and for the gospel will save it. ³⁶ What good is it for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit



their soul? ³⁷ Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul? ³⁸ If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels."

Up until this point there had been a certain amount of glamour for the disciples in following Jesus. They had witnessed miracle after miracle, received amazing teaching, and Jesus was like a superhero. It was cool to be in his gang. Suddenly that all changed. Like others in Israel Peter was expecting the Messiah to be a mighty leader who would overthrow Roman rule and occupation. What a let down! This would no longer be the cool gang to be in.

Now Jesus is saying that if Peter truly wants to follow Him it will be painful and costly, and Peter cannot have it all on his own terms. Jesus was calling Peter to reflect on whether he truly wanted to follow Christ, or just to follow his own idea of Christ. So it is for us. We cannot have God on our own terms. We cannot create a cosy religion to practice just on Sundays.

We are frequently challenged to differentiate between what is of God, and what is of our own ego. Sometimes we can even fool ourselves about which is which. This Lent we are called into a period of self-reflection — what does it mean for us to die to self? what does it mean for us to lay down our comfortable images of Christ and the church and to make room for the living Christ and the gospel ?
