AUSTERITY LUNCH supporting the TEARFUND APPEAL for humanitarian aid for ZIMBABWE SATURDAY 28th MARCH: 12 - 2 @ METHODIST CHAPEL

A total of 6.7 million Zimbabweans were classed as in urgent need of humanitarian assistance in December 2019. Contraction of agricultural production following an El Nino induced drought has worsened an already chaotic fiscal situation with inflation running at beyond 230 per cent. There is widespread rationing of water and electricity supplies. One tenth of rural households are going without food for whole days.
